Organization: Skidegate Youth Centre Project: Peer2Peer Support Staff

Award: \$10,000

The Peer2Peer Support Staff Project was born at the request of local teens following a conversation on how the community can better support them as they work through life's challenges. Two teen workers are hired who are in charge of organizing and running the weekly Friday Teen Night. But they are more

than that, acting as the initial points of contact for the 50-60 youth aged 13-19 who participate in the program throughout the course of the year. Should those youth require additional assistance they are there to help connect them to the appropriate community supports with the aid of the Youth Centre Coordinator.

The Field Trip fund provides direct funding to School District 50 to assist in offsetting travel costs for school teams, classes, and clubs to participate in Field Trips.

Eligible uses of the grant

- Travel by air, train, bus, taxi fares and/or ferry, including berths
- Car rental
- Accommodation costs
- Food to a maximum of \$80/day
- Registration fees
